#### SUBSIDY UNDER PMFME

### 1059. SHRI M. MOHAMED ABDULLA:

Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) total number of beneficiaries who availed subsidy under the Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) Scheme in the last two years in the State of Tamil Nadu, district-wise;
- (b) the average time it takes to process the application and disbursal of subsidy;
- (c) whether Government is aware of the issues faced by the beneficiaries under PMFME where the banks summarily reject projects with value less than 10 lakhs; and
- (d) the steps taken by Government in this regard to ensure credit facilities to the beneficiaries as intended?

#### ANSWER

# THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) A total of 1321 beneficiaries have availed subsidy in the State of Tamil Nadu under the Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) Scheme in the last two years till 15<sup>th</sup> July 2023 as per details given at Annexure.

(b) The average time taken for processing of applications and disbursal of subsidy is 45 days and 35 days respectively.

(c) & (d) Handholding support is provided to the beneficiary for project formulation, execution, access to credit, linkages to machine/equipment manufacturers, maintenance of hygiene & quality control etc. through different components of the PMFME scheme such as promotional activities, capacity building, and marketing & branding.

It is not true that Banks are summarily rejecting the projects of value lessor than ₹10 lakhs, as the average size of sanctioned project is ₹6.3 lakh.
