#### **BULLET TRAIN PROJECTS**

#### 1076 SMT. PHULO DEVI NETAM:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of bullet train projects in action and planned across the country;
- (b) the reasons for delay in implementation of these projects;
- (c) whether Railways have considered any proposal for operating more number of bullet trains (fast trains) in different railway zones/routes of the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF RAILWAYS, COMMUNICATIONS AND ELECTRONICS & INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI ASHWINI VAISHNAW)

- (a): The Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail (MAHSR) Project is the only sanctioned High Speed Rail project in the country. The current status of the MAHSR Project is as under:
  - Out of total land requirement of approx. 1389.5 ha. about 1381.9 ha. land acquired.
  - 1612 out of 1651 utilities shifted.
  - All the civil contracts of the project has been awarded.
  - The entire project has been divided into 28 Contract packages. At present, 23 packages have been awarded.
  - Total 69.8 Km of Girder have been Launched (Superstructure), 95.4 km of Girder Casting have been done, 248.64 km of foundation and 206.96 km of the pier have been completed.
- (b): Delay in land acquisition especially in the State of Maharashtra and consequent delays in finalization of contracts have impacted the project implementation.
- (c) and (d): Ministry of Railways has assigned the work for preparation of Survey/Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the following seven High Speed Rail (HSR) Corridor/Project to National High Speed Rail Corporation Limited (NHSRCL):
  - (i) Delhi Varanasi
  - (ii) Delhi -Ahmedabad
  - (iii) Mumbai-Nagpur
  - (iv) Mumbai -Hyderabad
  - (v) Chennai Mysore
  - (vi) Delhi Amritsar
  - (vii) Varanasi-Howrah
