- (a) Provisions of reservation have been followed in contractual employments.
- (b) and (c) Indian Railways (IR) executes a wide range of works for creation, repair and maintenance of its various assets including stations, coaches, wagons, coaching depots, locomotives, tracks, etc pertaining to various departments namely Mechanical, Commercial, Electrical, Civil Engineering, Signal & Telecommunication, Medical, etc. These works are executed through its own workers and/or through outsourcing through contracting agencies. Outsourcing is done by Railways on need basis from time to time in order to improve the services and efficiency in operation and the number of works being done through outsourcing job varies from time to time according to requirement.

Occurrence and filling up of vacancies is a continuous process and Railways are constantly working to fill up the vacancies as per their operational requirements.
