SUBSIDY TO TEXTILE MANUFACTURING UNITS

- (a) whether Government has any plan to provide subsidy to the small textile manufacturing units, particularly in Maharashtra;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the details of the textile units approved by Government in Maharashtra so far?

(a) & (b): Ministry of Textiles has been providing subsidy support to textile industry, including Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) and small textile manufacturing units across the country including Maharashtra through schemes such as Amended Technology Upgradation Fund Scheme (ATUFS) and Powertex India. Details of support provided under the schemes are given in **Annexure-I**.

(c): Details of textile units in Maharashtra provided support under ATUFS and Powertex India scheme are given in **Annexure-II**.
