#### ANSWER

# Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD))

(a) There is no specific budget allocation under Krishi Udan Scheme. However, for facilitating and incentivising movement of agri-produce by air transportation, waiver of Landing charges, Parking charges, etc. are provided for Indian freighters and P2C (Passenger-to-Cargo) Aircraft by Airports Authority of India (AAI) and Ministry of Defence at selected airports under Krishi Udan Scheme.

(b) & (c) Yes, Sir. At present, Adampur, Amritsar and Pathankot airports in Punjab are included under the Krishi Udan Scheme.

(d) As stated above, there is no specific budget allocation under Krishi Udan Scheme.

(e) & (f) Krishi Udan is an ongoing Scheme and is reviewed from time to time in consultation with stakeholders.
