(a) to (d): No such proposal has been received. However, under the Regional Connectivity Scheme(RCS)-Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagrik (UDAN) Scheme, 24 Routes have been operationalised connecting airports in Odisha.

The airstrips at Amarda, Jeypore, Jharsuguda, Rangeilunda, Rourkela and Utkela have been identified for development and operationalisation under RCS-UDAN Scheme. RCS flight operations have commenced from Jharsuguda, Jeypore and Rourkela airports.
