**RESTORING OPERATION OF SMALL AIRCRAFT AND AIR
AMBULANCE IN AMARWAH, MADHYA PRADESH**

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) the reasons for discontinuing the flight services of small planes and air ambulances for the last five years from Amarwah airstrip of Sidhi District;
- (b) whether this airstrip is being expanded or overhauled; and
- (c) if so, the name of the agency for this work and by when it will be completed so that the said flight service could be restored?

(a) to (c): Amarwah Airstrip belongs to the Government of Madhya Pradesh. It has been informed by the State Government that since the repair and expansion work of Airstrip was in progress, the flight services of small planes and air ambulance were discontinued. The work at the airstrip has now been completed by the State Government.
