(a) to (c) Government of India is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal, since August, 2019, in partnership with States, to make provision of potable tap water supply in adequate quantity, of prescribed quality and on regular & long-term basis to every rural household in the country, including in Himachal Pradesh.

As reported by the State Government, as on 26/07/2023, all the 17.09 lakh rural households in Himachal Pradesh are reported to have tap water supply in their homes. District-wise status of tap water connections in rural households in Himachal Pradesh is **annexed**.
