JAL JEEVAN MISSION SCHEME IN URBAN AND RURAL HOUSEHOLDS

1212#. SHRIMATI SEEMA DWIVEDI:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has the data of the houses of the beneficiaries under the Jal Jeevan Mission Scheme;
- (b) if so, the number of urban and rural households benefitted under the Jal Jeevan Mission (Har Ghar Jal) Scheme; and
- (c) the State-wise details thereof for the last three years?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI

(SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) to (c) Since August 2019, Government of India, in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household by 2024.

Since launch of JJM, additional 9.42 Crore rural households have been provided tap connections. Thus, as on 26.07.2023, out of 19.42 Crore rural households in the country, provision of tap water supply has been made to 12.65 Crore (65%) households. As reported by States on JJM-IMIS, State/ UT-wise details of tap connections provided during last three years, are at **Annex-I**.

Further, as reported by Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, 172 lakhs tap connections are provided under AMRUT scheme & convergence in Urban area. The details of tap connections in urban area for the last three years, are at **Annex-II**.
