WOMEN ENTREPRENEURS IN THE MSME SECTOR

1235. SHRI DEREK O'BRIEN:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the number and percentage of MSMEs headed by women in the country, State-wise;
- (b) the number of women-owned MSMEs closed down due to the Pandemic; and
- (c) whether Government has schemes providing dedicated support to encourage more women-led MSMEs?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI BHANU PRATAP SINGH VERMA)

- (a): As per the Udyam Registration Portal, the details of number and percentage of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) headed by women in the country, State-wise are at Annexure-I.
- (b): As per the Udyam Registration Portal, launched on 01.07.2020, the total number of women-owned MSMEs closed down/shut down till 25.07.2023 are 4,502.
- (c): The Government has taken a number of initiatives to support women owned MSMEs, in the country. Some of these include:
 - (i) Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) mandates Central Ministries/Departments/ Undertakings to procure at least 3% of their annual procurement from women-owned MSEs.
 - (ii) To support Women Entrepreneurs under Credit Guarantee Scheme for Micro & Small Enterprises, recently, two provisions have been introduced for women entrepreneurs. They are:
 - (a) 10% concession in annual Guarantee fee; and
 - (b) 10 % additional Guarantee coverage of up to 85%.
 - (iii) Under the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), women entrepreneurs are provided higher subsidy (25% and 35% in urban and rural areas, respectively).
 - (iv) Launch of "SAMARTH 2.0" to support women-owned MSMEs on 08.03.2023. Under the Samarth initiative of the Ministry, following benefits are available to aspiring and existing women entrepreneurs:
 - (a) 20% Seats in free Skill Development Programmes organized by the Ministry of MSME has been allocated for Women.

- (b) 20% of MSME Business Delegations sent to domestic & international exhibitions under the schemes for Marketing Assistance implemented by Ministry has been dedicated to women owned MSMEs.
- (c) 20% Discount on annual processing fee on NSIC's Commercial Schemes.
- (d) Special Drive for registration of women-owned MSMEs under Udyam Registration.
- (v) Under Procurement and Marketing Support Scheme (PMSS), women owned micro and small enterprises can avail 100% subsidy on built up space rent paid for participation in trade fairs/ exhibition.
- (vi) To encourage entrepreneurship among women, Ministry of MSME implements 'Skill Upgradation & Mahila Coir Yojana' under Coir Vikas Yojana, which is as an exclusive training programme aimed at skill development of women artisans engaged in the Coir industry.
