FEMALE-LED MSMEs

1237. SHRI B. PARTHASARADHI REDDY:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the number of MSMEs run by women entrepreneurs in Telangana;
- (b) the State which has the highest number of MSMEs run by women entrepreneurs;
- (c) the details of the loan disbursed under various schemes to women-led MSMEs, State-wise in the last five years
- (d) whether Government is aware about the issues, female-led MSMEs face in accessing credit facilities to run their businesses; and
- (e) if so, the schemes available to empower women entrepreneurs and promote the ease of doing business for women?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES
(SHRI BHANU PRATAP SINGH VERMA)

- (a): As on 25.07.2023, as per Udyam Registration Portal, the total number of women owned Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises registered since inception (01.07.2020) to 25.07.2023 in Telangana was 1,37,542.
- (b): The number of women owned MSMEs registered on Udyam registration Portal (as on 25.07.2023) in the state of Maharashtra was 6,62,894, which is the highest in the country.
- (c): The details of the financial support extended under the Credit Guarantee Scheme (CGS) for Micro and Small Enterprises to women –owned MSMEs in the country during the last five years are as follows:

(d) & (e): The Government has taken a number of initiatives to support MSMEs, including women owned enterprises in the country, which include:

- i. To support Women Entrepreneurs under Credit Guarantee Scheme for Micro & Small Enterprises, two provisions have been introduced for women entrepreneurs w.e.f. 01.12.2022. These are:
 - a) 10% concession in annual Guarantee fees; and
 - b) 10 % additional Guarantee coverage of up to 85%, as against the 75 % for other entrepreneurs.
- ii. The Ministry also implements Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), which is a major credit-linked subsidy programme aimed at generating self-employment opportunities through establishment of micro enterprises in the non-farm sector by helping traditional artisans and rural/urban unemployed youth. Under the scheme, women are provided higher subsidy (up to 35%) vis-a-vis non-special category (up to 25%).
- iii. To benefit women entrepreneurs, the Public Procurement Policy was amended in 2018 mandating Central Ministries/Departments/ Undertakings to procure at least 3% of their annual procurement from women entrepreneurs.
- iv. To encourage entrepreneurship among women, Ministry of MSME implements 'Skill Upgradation & Mahila Coir Yojana' under Coir Vikas Yojana, which is an exclusive training program aimed at skill development of women artisans engaged in the Coir sector.
- v. Participation of women entrepreneurs in trade fairs under Procurement & Marketing Support Scheme is subsidized 100% vis-a-vis 80% for other entrepreneurs.
- vi. Launch of "SAMARTH" to support women-owned MSMEs.
