**DATA ON MSMEs OWNED BY WOMEN, SC/ST/OBC ETC.**

1243. SHRI SUJEET KUMAR:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) with reference to the Survey, Studies and Policy Research (SS&PR) Scheme, whether there is a data base available on the number of MSMEs owned by Woman, SC/ ST, OBC etc;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefore;
- (d) the number of unregistered MSMEs, State-wise; and
- (e) the total amount of grants disbursed to MSMEs owned by Women, SC/ ST, OBC, in the last three years?

(e): The details of the amount of grants disbursed to MSMEs owned by Women, SC/ST, OBC in the last three years is as under.

i. The details on Margin money (MM) disbursed (in cr.) to MSME owned by Women, SC/ST and OBC under Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) during the last three years is given below:

ii. National Scheduled Caste Scheduled Tribe Hub (NSSH) scheme, was launched in 2016 by the Hon'ble Prime Minister with aim at capacity enhancement of SC-ST entrepreneurs and promoting "entrepreneurship culture" amongst the SC-ST population. NSSH scheme is empowering SC-ST population to participate in the public procurement process and fulfill the mandated target of 4% procurement from SC-ST enterprises under Public Procurement Policy by the Ministries, Departments and CPSEs. Under National SC-ST Hub scheme, grant released by the Ministry of MSME, GoI is utilized by NSIC under different activities / interventions with the approval of Project Screening Committee for NSSH e.g. capacity building training programs, participation in exhibitions under SMAS component, organizing SVDPs, Awareness programs, Mega events / Conclaves and subsidies. The grant is released to the respective training institutions / organizers of exhibitions, vendors, except subsidy under Special Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme (SCLCSS) and various reimbursement subsidy schemes under NSSH. Reimbursement are also made to SC/ST MSEs under various interventions of NSSH scheme to enhance their competitiveness. These include reimbursement of Bank Loan Process Fee / Bank charges for Performance Bank Guarantee / Testing Fee / membership fee of Export Promotion Councils / Course Fees of Top 50 NIRF ranked Management Institutions for short term training of SC/ST entrepreneurs. The subsidy as reimbursement as per NSSH guideline is released with the approval of NSSH-PSC to the applicant SC/ST MSEs. The details of grant disbursed under the above SCLCSS and various interventions of NSSH scheme during last 3 years for SC/ST MSEs (including women SC/ST) are as under:
