#### 1266 # SHRI ADITYA PRASAD:

Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of ongoing development works in the selected aspirational districts in Jharkhand; and
- (b) the details of developmental achievements made so far under this programme in these districts over the last five years?

#### **ANSWER**

(a) The Aspirational Districts Programme, launched in 2018, is implemented in 112 districts across the country. 19 out of 24 districts in Jharkhand are part of the programme. Under the Aspirational Districts Programme, efforts are being made to bring rapid transformation across 5 sectors, i.e. Health & Nutrition, Education, Financial Inclusion & Skill Development, Agriculture & Water Resources and Basic Infrastructure.

As the main strategy of the programme is based on convergence of existing schemes which have their own funding arrangement, large infusion of additional funds is not envisaged. However, in order to foster competitive spirit, and for addressing the critical gaps, additional allocation on challenge routes is also provisioned. Every month, districts are assessed on the basis of monthly progress and the best performing District in overall terms, in each of the five sectors, are identified. The first and second rankers in overall terms are awarded Rs. 10 crores and Rs. 5 crores respectively. The first ranker from each of the five sectors is awarded Rs. 3 crores each. Using these funds, districts in Jharkhand have taken up development work to address the critical gaps in the districts. The list of projects sanctioned in the Aspirational Districts of Jharkhand is given as Annexure I.

(b) Aspirational Districts have achieved significant improvement since inception of the Programme. Details of district-wise performance (overall and theme-wise) since inception for aspirational districts is available on the Champions of Change Portal (<a href="http://championsofchange.gov.in/site/coc-home/">http://championsofchange.gov.in/site/coc-home/</a>) which is in the public domain. Details of district-wise performance (overall) since inception for the aspirational districts of the State of Jharkhand are attached as Annexure II.
