- (a) whether it is a fact that Government is working towards filling all the existing Central Government vacancies and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of total number of recruitment made by Government in the last five years including the current year, year-wise and Ministry-wise; and
- (c) the details of total number of recruitment made by Government in the last five years, year-wise including the current year, group-wise, and category-wise including SCs, STs and OBCs?

ANSWER

(a): Government has issued the instructions to all Ministries/ Departments for timely filling up of the unfilled posts. Rozgaar Melas being organized by Government of India are expected to act as catalyst in filling up of all vacant posts.

(b) & (c): Total candidates recommended by UPSC, SSC and RRBs from 01.04.2018 to 31.03.2023 including SCs, STs and OBCs are 4,63,205. Apart from this, SSC and RRBs have recommended 1,03,196 candidates for appointment in the 1^{st} quarter of 2023-24.
