Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:-

- (a) the amount of small savings that has been collected in each year during the last three years in different States of the country and the ratio of such savings to the GDP;
- (b) the details of utilization of such savings during the said period, sector-wise;
- (c) whether Government has any plan to encourage more savings in Tripura along with other States of the country in future; and;
- (d) if so, the details of existing schemes in this regard?

- (a) State-wise details for the last three years is attached as ‘Annexure-1’. The ratio of total net collection under Small Savings Schemes to the GDP is in table below.

- (b) The total net collection under the Small Savings Schemes is invested in Special Central Government Securities and Special State Government Securities of the States who have opted for investment from NSSF such as Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, and Delhi.
- (c) & (d) The Government takes various measures to promote savings under the Small Savings Schemes. These schemes are being given proper publicity for information and awareness of the investors by the Government from time to time.
