### NURSING COLLEGES IN THE COUNTRY

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Union Cabinet has cleared the setting up of 157 new nursing colleges in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (c) the details of fund allocated and released for setting up of nursing colleges in the country during the year 2023-24, State-wise?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (Dr. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

- (a) & (b) Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for "Establishment of new Medical College attached with existing district/referral hospital" 157 medical colleges have been approved since 2014. Establishment of 157 nursing colleges have been announced in the budget speech 2023-24 in these medical colleges. State-wise list of nursing colleges is annexed.
- (c) The funding pattern for the establishment of these 157 nursing colleges is as under:
