VACCINATION UNDER MISSION INDRADHANUSH

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of vaccinated, partially vaccinated and completely unvaccinated under Mission Indradhanush (MI) with coverage percentage and numbers as on date in the State of Maharashtra, district-wise;
- (b) the number of high focus districts under MI in Maharashtra and their coverage as on date; and
- (c) the details on more than 90 per cent and 100 per cent immunization coverage achieved districts in the State of Maharashtra?

- (a) Mission Indradhnaush (MI) is a special catch-up campaign under Universal Immunization Porgramme (UIP), conducted in the areas of low immunization coverage to vaccinate all the children and pregnant women left out or dropped out from Routine Immunization. The number and percentage of children fully vaccinated and unvaccinated/partially vaccinated under Routine Immunization in the State of Maharashtra, district wise is placed at Annexure I.
- (b) Intensified Mission Indradhanush (IMI) 4.0 was conducted in 10 high focus districts of Maharashtra in 2022. Number of children vaccinated under IMI 4.0, district wise in the State of Maharashtra is placed at Annexure II.
- (c) As per Health Management Information System 2022-23, 25 districts have achieved 100% Full Immunization Coverage (FIC) whereas 10 districts have achieved FIC of more than 90%.
