#### Janaushadhi Kendras in Maharashtra

#### 1393 Dr. Anil Sukhdeorao Bonde:

Will the Minister of **Chemicals and Fertilizers** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP) Kendras opened/expanded as decided in the meeting of Committee of Secretaries set up by Hon'ble Prime Minister in 2015, to deliberate on health-related issues as on 31.12.2021;
- (b) the number of such Kendras running in Maharashtra as on date and the performance of them;
- (c) whether Government is planning to increase Janaushadhi Kendras in the State of Maharashtra; and (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI BHAGWANTH KHUBA)

- (a): With a view to make quality generic medicines at affordable prices available to all, 'Jan Aushadhi Scheme' was launched by the Government in November, 2008 with a target to open at least one Jan Aushadhi Kendra in every district of the country. About 80 Kendras were opened in the country till 2014-15. During 2015-16, the scheme was revamped and relaunched as 'Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana' (PMBJP) with a target to set up 3,000 Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras (PMBJKs) in the country. The said target was achieved in December, 2017. About 8,640 PMBJKs were opened till 31.12.2021. The number of Kendras have since grown to about 9,512 as on 30.06.2023.
- (b): About 650 PMBJKs have been opened in the State of Maharashtra as on 30.06.2023. During the financial year 2022-23, sale of about Rs. 12.59 crore has been made through these *Kendras* in the state of Maharashtra.
- (c) & (d): A target to open 10,000 PMBJKs by March, 2024 has been decided. No State/UT-wise specific target has, however, been kept.
