Mapping of school going students dislocated after Manipur violence

1470 Ms. Dola Sen:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has data of school going children who have been dislocated due to the current Manipur crisis;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether Government has done any mapping of such children for rehabilitation purposes; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): As per information provided by the State Government of Manipur, a total of 14763 school going children have been displaced due to the current Manipur situation. A nodal officer has been appointed for each relief camp to facilitate the admission process of the displaced students. 93.5% of the displaced students have been admitted to a nearest feasible school, free of cost. The district-wise breakup of displaced students along with status of students admitted is attached at Annexure.
