The Government has sanctioned establishment of Research Parks at IITs – Madras, Bombay, Kharagpur, Hyderabad, Gandhinagar and IISc Bangalore to augment the research ecosystem in the country. The research park at IIT Madras, Kharagpur and Delhi are functional and others are in advanced stage of completion. In the last five years Rs. 364 Crores have been released for construction of these Research Parks.
