Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has the data regarding the funds released to various States during the last three years under Rashtriya Uchcharat Shiksha Abhiyan;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) whether Government has any plans to increase funds for Higher Education Institutions in Rajasthan under RUSA; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b): The details of funds released to various States/ UTs, under the Rashtriya Uchcharat Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), during the last three years is Annexed.

(c) & (d): The government has approved the next phase of RUSA in the form of Pradhan Mantri Uchcharat Shiksha Abhiyan (PM-USHA) with an outlay of Rs. 12926.10 crore for the period 2023-24 to 2025-26. Fund approval under this scheme would be dependent upon the proposals submitted by the States/UTs based on the guidelines of the scheme.
