- (a) & (b) 1077 Hectare of land out of 1082 hectare required for widening of National Highway (NH) 66 in the State of Kerala has been acquired and is under possession of National Highways Authority of India (NHAI).
- (c) to (e) The main reason for delay in land acquisition is huge number of litigations and stay orders issued against possession of the land by various Hon'ble courts. Efforts have been made with the help of Government of Kerala by NHAI to take possession of the balance land.
