Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the length of National Highways, State Highways and other roads in the country, lane-wise till date;
- (b) their respective length and the number of lanes, percentage-wise; and
- (c) the total length of National Highways constructed year-wise for last 5 years till date, employing the lane-kilometer methodology?

(a) and (b) The Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs). Total length of NHs in the country is about 1,46,145 km at present. Lane wise configuration is as under: -
