### FOUR LANING OF NHs IN KARNATAKA

### 1531. SHRI MALLIKARJUN KHARGE:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that NH-50 and NH-150A providing important connectivity to the Kalyana Karnataka region, have only two lanes which has resulted in overcrowding and a sharp increase in road accidents in the region;
- (b) whether the Ministry has sanctioned four-lane roadwork for NH-50 and NH-150A connecting Bidar to Chamarajanagar;
- (c) if so, the current status and completion deadline of the roadwork thereof, and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) details of the current timeline for sanction and completion of the four-laning of the NHs mentioned above?

### **ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) to (d) NH- 50 of total length 639 km, has 18 km of 6 lane, 322 km of 4 lane and the balance length has 2 Lane / 2 Lane + Paved Shoulders configuration. NH- 150A with total length of 637 km, has 162 km of 4 lane, 93 km of 2 lane / 2 lane with paved shoulders and the balance length has Intermediate Lane / Single Lane configuration. Development / widening of National Highways is an ongoing process which is taken up as per traffic levels, availability of funds and inter-se priority. Details of ongoing works on NH-50 and NH-150A are at Annexure-I and Annexure-II respectively. The traffic levels on the stretches with 2 lane / 2 lane with paved shoulders are within their capacity and no increase in accidents thereon are reported.
