PMKVY IN TELANGANA

1563. DR. K. LAXMAN:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) the details of total number of youths, male and female separately, who have been enrolled from Telangana for skill development training under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) during last three years.
- (b) the total number of youths in the State, male and female separately, who have got registered in the Atmanirbhar Skilled Employees Employer Mapping (ASEEM) portal launched by Government and have got employment or placement after training during last three years:
- (c) the total amount of funds allotted and spent for this program during last three years; and
- (d) the number of courses offered by Government under various schemes?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(a) The Skill India Mission (SIM) of the Govt. of India is aimed at Skilling, Re-skilling and Up-skilling to ensure our youth are prepared for the large number of opportunities coming up as the economy expands and India moves from the 10th largest economy to 3rd largest economy in the world. SIM is aimed at future ready and Industry ready talent among the youths.

Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE) launched Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) in 2015 for delivering skills, Re-Skill and Up-skill training to the youths of the country including the State of Telangana through Short Term Training (STT) and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). The details of total number of youths, male and female, who have been enrolled from Telangana for skill development training under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) during the last three years is given below:

(b) As on 30.06.2023, total 3,568 male and 3,772 female candidates have been registered in Atmanirbhar Skilled Employees Employer Mapping (ASEEM) portal from the State of Telangana. ASEEM portal is a directory of skilled workforce and not a placement portal. The portal is a platform that matches supply of skilled workforce with the market demand, thereby facilitating better livelihood opportunities for youths and availability of ready skilled manpower to employers. The number of candidates certified under the placement linked STT component of PMKVY during the last three years (2020-21 to 2022-23) in the State of Telangana is 26,335; out of which 12,073 candidates have been reported placed.

(c) PMKVY 2.0 (2016-20) and 3.0 (2020-22) were implemented through two components, viz, Centrally Sponsored Centrally Managed (CSCM) or Central Component and Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM) or State Component. Under the State Component of PMKVY 2.0 and 3.0, an amount of Rs. 71.13 Crore and Rs 8.58 Crore were allocated to the State of Telangana. Out of which, Rs. 31.55 Crore and Rs.3.97 Crore were disbursed to the state. The total utilization under the State Component of PMKVY 2.0 and 3.0 till 30.6.2023 is Rs. 25.52 Crore. Further, as on 30.6.2023, Rs. 295.62 Crore has been utilised for the implementation of the Central Component of PMKVY in the State of Telangana, details of which is given below:-

(d) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is imparting various short term training in National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) aligned courses through the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) and through Jan Shikshan Santhans (JSSs). Under PMKVY (2023-24), 727 NSQF aligned job roles along with 119 job roles in new age courses are being offered. Similarly, 50 courses in 23 Sectors are being offered through various Jan Shikshan Santhans (JSSs). For long term training, under the Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS), 152 NSQF aligned course are being offered through various ITIs across the country.
