- (a) the steps taken for the promotion of Malayalam after awarding it the status of Classical Language;
- (b) the year-wise allocation of fund by the Union government for Malayalam and other Classical Languages, language-wise details of funding for the last five years; and
- (c) whether Government has any plan to set up Departments of Malayalam in Central Institutes or Universities?

(a) to (c) Central Institute of Indian Languages (CIIL), Mysuru, under the Ministry of Education has set up a Centre of Excellence for Studies in Classical Malayalam (CESCM) at Thunchathezuthachan Malayalam University, Tirur, Kerala. The main objective of the center is to work on various schemes and activities to promote, propagate and preserve the language inside and outside its speech territories among many other academic activities including digitization, procure manuscripts, documentations, etc. of Classical Malayalam language.

As CIIL Mysuru works for the promotion of all Indian languages including Scheduled/Non-Scheduled and Classical languages, grants for the institute are

not released language wise. However, the details of funds provided for promotion and preservation of various classical languages are given below:
