#### INCENTIVES TO IT SECTOR FOR ACCELERATING EXPORTS

#### 1800. SHRI S. SELVAGANABATHY:

Will the Minister of COMMERCE & INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government proposes to provide incentives to IT sector to accelerate the growth and help services exports to reach \$1 trillion at the end of this decade, if so, details thereof;
- (b) whether Government has set any target for merchandise exports for current fiscal, if so, details thereof and steps taken to achieve the same;
- (c) whether Government proposes to start IT hubs in Tier-2 and Tier-3 towns and cities and if so, details thereof;
- (d) the details of funds sanctioned and released so far for that purpose; and
- (e) the details of locations identified for establishing such IT hubs?

#### **ANSWER**

# THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

- (a) Incentives for exports to various sectors to meet medium to long term targets are provided based on assessment of various factors, including requirements of a sector, overall global economic scenario, and incentive structures available in the competing geographies.
- (b) Presently, no target has been fixed for merchandise exports for the current fiscal.
- (c) to (e) Software Technology Parks of India (STPI), an autonomous society under Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), is instrumental in proliferating digital technologies across the country to drive Government's initiatives to smaller towns. These STPI centres are offering state-of-art infrastructure facilities including plug-n-play facility, centralized computing and High-Speed Data Communication. As on date, STPI has set-up 63 STPI centres across the country, out of

which, 55 STPI centres are in Tier-II and Tier-III cities. Further, Government of India has also approved 22 new STPI centres across the country in Tier-II and Tier-III cities. State/ UT-wise list of existing and approved STPI Centres are at **Annexure-I and Annexure-II.** 

As per policy for setting up a new STPI Centre, State Government or centres of Excellence/ Higher Educational Institution is required to provide minimum 2 acres of developed land or 50,000 sq. ft. built-up area free of cost on long term lease. In case, State Government/Centres of Excellence/Higher Educational Institution provides minimum 2 acres of land, STPI will construct minimum 20,000 sq. ft. built-up space. While the initiative for setting up a new STPI centre lies with the State Government, STPI jointly with the State Government concerned is required to conduct a feasibility study to evaluate the export potential and commercial viability of the proposed location. The cost for setting up of new STPI centre shall be borne by STPI only from its internal accruals. Hence, no funds are allocated by the Government for the same.
