IMPORT DUTY ON NATURAL AND COMPOUND RUBBER

1805. SHRI JOSE K. MANI:

Will the Minister of COMMERCE & INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) the prices of natural rubber in the country over the last five years;
- (b) whether Government has any plan to increase the import duty on all dry forms of natural rubber and on compound rubber to a minimum of 50 per cent;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether Government has any plan to impose anti-dumping duty on natural rubber imported from Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) countries; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) The yearly average prices of natural rubber (NR) in the domestic markets for the last five years are as under:

- **(b)& (c):** Presently, no such proposal is under consideration. The Government had increased the duty on import of dry rubber to 25% or Rs.30 per kg whichever is lower w.e.f. 30.04.2015, which is equal to WTO bound rate. Further, in the Union Budget 2023-24, the rate of custom duty on compound rubber has been increased from 10% to 25%.
- (d)& (e): The Government considers anti-dumping measures on the basis of application filed by domestic industry. Currently, there is no application received/pending for initiation of anti-dumping investigation on natural rubber with Directorate General of Trade Remedies.
