PRIVATISATION IN RAILWAYS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that there is a move towards privatising production units under operations within the railway sector;
- (b) if so, the reasons behind it;
- (c) if not, justify the same;
- (d) data on recruitment of railway staff between 2018-2023 across operations and technical teams; and
- (e) data on their salary between 2018-2023 across operations and technical teams?

ANSWER MINISTER OF RAILWAYS, COMMUNICATIONS AND ELECTRONICS & INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI ASHWINI VAISHNAW)

- (a) No, Sir.
- (b) Does not arise.
- (c) The present setup is functioning well as per the Indian Railways requirement.
- (d) 1,02,753 (Provisional) candidates have been empanelled against operating and technical posts by Railway Recruitment Boards (RRBs) for Group C posts and 1,07,515 (Provisional) candidates have been empanelled in Level 1 (erstwhile group D) between 2018-2023.
- (e) The revenue expenditure on pay & allowances of railway staff for the years between 2018-2023 is Rs. 4,37,090 Crores (Provisional).
