(a) to (c): In September 2019, an administrative arrangement between Indian Railways and European Commission for promoting safe, effective, efficient and sustainable development of Railway transportation was signed.

The cooperation areas broadly pertain to:

- Rail Reform and Regulations.
- Railway Safety.
- Signalling/control systems.
- Intermodality and transport infrastructure networks.
- Innovation and digitisation.

The scheme does not cover any specific locations/stations or platforms in any State.
