## FILLING UP OF VACANCIES IN RAILWAYS

## 1904 SHRI RYAGA KRISHNAIAH:

(a) the number of vacancies in the Indian Railways in the last three years, zone-wise;
(b) the reasons for the high number of vacancies;
(c) whether Government has taken any concrete steps towards timely filling up of these vacancies;
(d) if so, the details thereof, including the number of vacancies filled up in the last three years and if not, the reasons therefor;
(e) whether Government has formulated any policy roadmap or strategy for ensuring timebound filling up of vacancies; and
(f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (f) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 1904 BY SHRI RYAGA KRISHNAIAH ANSWERED IN RAJYA SABHA ON 04.08.2023 REGARDING FILLING UP OF VACANCIES IN RAILWAYS
(a) : The detail of vacancies in Indian Railways in last three years, zone-wise is appended.
(b) to (f): Indian Railways is a large organisation. Occurrence and filling up of vacancies are continuous process on Indian Railways considering its size, spatial distribution and criticality of operation. The vacancies are filled up primarily by placement of indents by Railways with Recruitment agencies as per operational requirements.

Regarding Group ' C ' (Including Level-1) posts, a massive recruitment exercise has been completed recently for empanelling $1,39,050$ candidates by conducting Computer Based Test (CBT) of approximately 2.37 crore candidates.

CBT for Centralized Employment Notification (CEN) 01/2019 for Non-Technical Popular Categories (NTPC) was conducted for 1.26 crore candidates in 133 shifts in 68 days across 211 cities and 726 centres in 15 languages. Similarly, CBT for CEN-RRC 01/2019 (Level-1) was conducted for 1.11 crore candidates in 99 shifts in 33 days across 191 cities and 551 centres in 15 languages.

The details of candidates empanelled to Group ' C ' posts (including Level-1) in last three years are as under:
