(a) & (b): Under the UDAN scheme, the following 05 Selected Airline Operators (SAO) have been awarded routes to operate RCS flights in the state of Madhya Pradesh - Alliance Air, Indigo, SpiceJet, Star Air, Fly Big.

(c): As per National Monetisation Pipeline (NMP), 25 AAI airports namely, Bhubaneshwar, Varanasi, Amritsar, Trichy, Indore, Raipur, Calicut, Coimbatore, Nagpur, Patna, Madurai, Surat, Ranchi, Jodhpur, Chennai, Vijayawada, Vadodara, Bhopal, Tirupati, Hubli, Imphal, Agartala, Udaipur, Dehradun and Rajahmundry have been earmarked for leasing over the years 2022 to 2025.
