(a) to (d) The Government of India is implementing Flood Management Programme (FMP) since XI plan from its own resources as a centrally sponsored scheme. To strengthen the structural measures of flood management, Ministry had implemented Flood Management Programme (FMP) during XI & XII Plan for providing Central Assistance to the States for works related to flood control, anti-erosion, drainage development, anti-sea erosion, etc. Subsequently, FMP has been continued as a component of Flood Management and Border Areas Programme (FMBAP). 427 completed projects under FMP have given protection to an area of around 4.994 Mha and protected a population of about 53.57 million.
