**HAR GHAR NAL SE JAL YOJNA**

2020. SHRI VIJAY PAL SINGH TOMAR:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of work done under Har Ghar Nal Se Jal Yojana in all parts of the country including Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) the achievement made by Government in this regard and the amount of funds released and used under this campaign during the last four years;
- (c) the estimated number of people benefitted under this scheme, district-wise; and
- (d) the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (d) Since August 2019, Government of India is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)-Har Ghar Jal in partnership with States to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household of the country including Uttar Pradesh. At the time of announcement of JJM, 3.23 Crore rural households in the country were reported to have tap water connections. Since then, additional 9.48 Crore rural households have been provided tap water connections. Thus, as on 02.08.2023, out of 19.41 Crore rural households in the country, provision of tap water supply has been made to 12.71 Crore (65.49%) households.

Further, 6 States & 3 UTs, 140 Districts, 1,428 Blocks, 85,330 Gram Panchayats and 1,78,422 villages are reported as 'Har Ghar Jal' as on 02.08.2023.

The year-wise details of Central fund released and fund utilization reported by the States/ UTs under JJM during the last four years, are given as under:
