Road construction in Mizoram

21 Shri K. Vanlalvena:

Will the Minister of DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government will restart the pending/cancelled road construction between Sangau village to Saisih Chhuah near Myanmar Border at Lawngtlai District, Mizoram; and
- (b) by when government will release the financial sanction for the construction of Road Keitum Chekawn N. Mualcheng Zawlsei which was submitted by PWD Mizoram through North Eastern Council (NEC), which was already approved by Ministry of DoNER this year?

ANSWER

The Minister of the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region [Shri G. Kishan Reddy]

- (a) The Sangau to Saisih Chhuah Road project was approved for Rs. 66.08 crore on 12th February, 2021 and due to non availability of encumbrance free land, Border Road Organisation (BRO) could not start the work. A committee was formed to look into the matter and find a way forward. The committee has submitted its report.
- (b) The Keitum Chekawn N. Mualcheng Zawlsei Road has not yet been sanctioned.
