- (a) the details of the coverage of measles and rubella cases in the year 2022, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether it is a fact that there were a large number of measles and rubella cases in that year;
- (c) the total number of children recorded to have been affected and number of those who received treatments along with casualties with State/UT-wise segmentation; and
- (d) the measures undertaken by Government to fully eliminate the risks of measles and rubella?

- (a) to (c) The number of Measles and Rubella cases and the number of those who received treatment along with casualties in the year 2022, State/UT wise is placed at Annexure I.
- (d) Following measures have been undertaken by Government for Measles and Rubella Elimination:
  - Measles and Rubella Vaccination campaign has been conducted nationwide wherein children in the age group of 9 months to 15 years were vaccinated with an additional dose of Measles and Rubella Vaccine.
  - A roadmap for Measles and Rubella (MR) Elimination has been prepared and disseminated to all the States/UTs with a focus to improve coverage of Measles and Rubella Vaccine and strengthen surveillance.
  - States/UTs reporting Measles outbreaks have been directed to conduct Outbreak Response Immunization (ORI) and Supplementary Immunization Activities (SIA) to increase the coverage of the vaccine and contain outbreaks.
