**Benefits from Samagara Shiksha Abhiyan**

2248 **Dr. C.M. Ramesh:**

Will the Minister of **Education** be pleased to state:

- (a) under Samagara Shiksha Abhiyan, how many Government schools have benefitted with construction of new class rooms, buildings and other facilities in different States of the country, State-wise, details thereof;
- (b) how many such proposals under the Scheme is pending for financial approval with Government of different States, State-wise, details thereof; and
- (c) which State of the country tops in fulfilling the targets set under this Scheme, details thereof?

**ANSWER**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

(a): The State wise details of classrooms, buildings and other infrastructure works sanctioned under Samagra Shiksha i.e. from 2018-19 upto June, 2023 is at Annexure-I.

(b): The Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education is implementing Samagra Shiksha from 2018-19 to support States and UTs for strengthening of existing Government schools and for creation and augmentation of infrastructure facilities based on the gaps determined from Unified District Information System for Education (UDISE+) and proposals received from respective State/ Union Territory. The need for schools and also the infrastructural facilities in schools are worked out every year by the respective State/Union Territory on incremental basis depending on their need and priority and reflected in their Annual Work Plan & Budget (AWP&B). These plans are then appraised and approved/estimated by the Project Approval Board (PAB) in the Department of School Education & Literacy in consultation with the States and Union Territories. The Project Approval Board (PAB) meetings for 2023-24 of all States/UTs are completed and proceedings transmitted to the states. After the PAB, the respective States/UTs implement the scheme as per approvals given by the PAB.

(c): The States/UTs are the implementing agencies for the scheme of Samagra Shiksha and the onus of timely completion of approved civil works is with the respective States/UTs. The States/UTs are repeatedly advised in various forums to ensure timely completion of civil works and update the progress on the PRABANDH portal. The physical and financial progress of the States/UTs are regularly monitored by this Department through the PRABANDH portal as well as through review meetings.
