ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SMT. ANNPURNA DEVI)

(a) to (c) The Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education is implementing Samagra Shiksha from 2018-19 to support States and UTs for strengthening of existing government schools and for creation and augmentation of infrastructure facilities, including funds for school building and others, based on the gaps determined from Unified District Information System for Education (UDISE+) and proposals received from respective State/UT. The need for schools and also the infrastructural facilities in schools are worked out every year by the respective State/Union Territory on incremental basis depending on their need and priority and reflected in their Annual Work Plan & Budget (AWP&B). These plans are then appraised and approved/estimated by the Project Approval Board (PAB) in the Department of School Education & Literacy in consultation with the States and UTs.

As per UDISE+ 2021-22, there are total 92695 number of Government schools in Madhya Pradesh, out of which 39 Higher Secondary, 198 Secondary Schools and 441 Elementary Schools are running without school building. In Sidhi and Singrauli districts of Madhya Pradesh, there are total 1784 and 1615 schools respectively, out of which 01 Secondary School & 03 Elementary Schools in Sidhi district and 01 Elementary School in Singrauli district are running without building.

The details of contribution being made by the Government in providing building to the schools in Madhya Pradesh since inception (SSA, RMSA and Samagra Shiksha) to June 2023 is placed below:
