Improving quality of education at primary level

2283. SHRI NEERAJ SHEKHAR:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of schemes being run by Government to improve quality of education at primary level along with augmentation of infrastructure in primary schools in the country, scheme-wise;
- (b) the details of fund allocated, released and utilised during 2021- 22, 2022-23 and 2023-24 till date, scheme-wise and State-wise; and
- (c) the details of percentage of primary schools covered under internet infrastructure/facility in the country as on date, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SMT. ANNPURNA DEVI)

(a): The details of schemes being run by Government to improve quality of education at primary level are as follows-

Samagra Shiksha

The Department of School Education and Literacy (DoSE&L) is implementing an integrated centrally sponsored scheme for School Education- Samagra Shiksha since 2018-19. It aims to ensure that all children have access to quality education with an equitable and inclusive classroom environment which should take care of their diverse background, multilingual needs, difference academic abilities and make them active participants in the learning process. Under the Scheme, support is provided to States and UTs for strengthening of existing Government schools and for creation and augmentation of infrastructure facilities, based on the gaps determined from Unified District Information System for Education (UDISE+) and proposals received from respective States/ Union Territories. Financial assistance is provided to all the States and UTs for undertaking various activities for Universalization of School Education including opening/strengthening of new schools upto senior secondary level,

construction of school buildings & additional classrooms, setting up, up-gradation and running of Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas, setting up and running of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Avasiya Vidyalayas, provision of free uniforms, free text books to the eligible students at elementary level, transport allowance and undertaking enrolment & retention drives.

Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM POSHAN)

Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM POSHAN) Scheme is one of the foremost rights based Centrally Sponsored Schemes implemented in partnership with States and UTs. The objectives of the scheme include improving the nutritional status of children studying in Bal Vatika (just before class-I) and classes I-VIII in Government and Government-aided schools; encouraging poor children to attend school more regularly and help them concentrate on classroom activities; and providing nutritional support to children of elementary stage in drought/disaster affected areas during summer vacation and disaster times.

Pradhan Mantri Schools for Rising India (PMSHRI)

PMSHRI is a centrally sponsored scheme approved by the Union Cabinet in September, 2022. The schools under the scheme including primary schools are to showcase the implementation of the National Education Policy 2020 and emerge as exemplar schools over a period of time, and also offer leadership to other schools in the neighborhood imparting high-quality education in an equitable, inclusive and joyful school environment that takes care of the diverse background, multilingual needs, and different academic abilities of children and makes them active participants in their own learning process as per vision of NEP 2020.In first phase, a total of 6207schools including KVS/NVS have been selected. Further, Central share of Rs. 630.11 crore as the 1st installment of FY 2023-24 has already been released to PMSHRI schools in 27 states /UTs including KVS/NVS.
