- (a) & (b): There are two Central Universities namely Dr. Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya (DHSGV), Sagar and Indira Gandhi National Tribal University (IGNTU), Amarkantak in Madhya Pradesh. These Central Universities have been continuously trying to disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional and research facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem fit; to make special provisions for integrated courses in humanities, social sciences, science and technology in its educational programmes; to take appropriate measures for promoting innovations in teaching-learning process and inter-disciplinary studies and research; to establish linkages with industries for the promotion of science and technology; and to pay special attention to the improvement of the social and economic conditions and welfare of the people, their intellectual, academic and cultural development.
