DISPARITY OF PENETRATION OF ELECTRIC VEHICLES IN INDIA

2349. SHRI B. LINGAIAH YADAV:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the number of electric vehicles in the country has surged from just 2,400 a decade ago to over 27.4 lakh as of July 2023, however, given the concurrent rise in the number of non-electric vehicles, the overall share of electric vehicles has still not crossed the 1 per cent mark and notably, there is also wide inter-State disparity in the penetration of electric vehicles; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and present status thereof?

(a) and (b) 1. The increase in number of electric and non-electric vehicles over the past decade is provided below. Presently, electric vehicles are 0.81% of the total vehicles (as on 03.08.2023).
