EMPLOYMENT STATISTICS OF PERSONS POST SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING

2364. SMT. MAHUA MAJI:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the schemes being run by Government for skill development of women, Scheduled Castes (SCs), Scheduled Tribes (STs), minorities, Divyangian and people from Economically Weaker Section (EWS);
- (b) the financial assistance provided to them for self-employment after imparting training, during the last five years and what arrangements for a market have been made available for the goods manufactured by them;
- (c) the number of persons who have been provided with employment after imparting skill development training during the last five years; and
- (d) the data of the backward States of the country, including Jharkhand, and the average income of the beneficiary after receiving this training in Jharkhand?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(a) The Skill India Mission (SIM) of the Government of India is aimed at skilling, re-skilling and upskilling to ensure our youth are prepared for the large number of opportunities coming up as the economy expands and India moves from the 10th largest economy to 3rd largest economy in the world. SIM is aimed at future ready and Industry ready skills for our youths.

Under SIM, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers skill, re-skill and up-skill training through various schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Sikhshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), to all the sections of the society including women, Scheduled Castes (SCs), Scheduled Tribes (STs), minorities, Divyangjan and people from Economically Weaker Section (EWS), across the country including in the State of Jharkhand.

- (b) Schemes of MSDE are aimed at equipping the youth of the country with market relevant skills to enable them to get gainfully engaged in wage or self employment. In addition to schemes for skill development, MSDE is also implementing programmes for entrepreneurship development through National Institute of Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development (NIESBUD) and Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship (IIE). Further, to boost self employment in the country, the government is implementing various schemes which include Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY), Stand-up India Scheme, Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) and schemes run by Khadi Village Industries Commission (KVIC) to generate self employment opportunities in traditional industries.
- (c) and (d) Out of the schemes of MSDE, placements are specifically tracked for the Short Term Training (STT) component under PMKVY. State-wise number of candidates reported placed under the STT component of PMKVY during the last five years is at Annexure-I. Average income of the candidates reported placed in the State of Jharkhand is Rs. 8132 per month.
