- (a) whether Government has formulated any action plan for providing training to the youth under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY);
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the State-wise details of number of youth trained under this scheme during the last three years and the amount spent for the same?

(a) & (b) The Skill India Mission (SIM) of the Government of India is aimed at skilling, re-skilling and up-skilling to ensure our youth are prepared for the large number of opportunities coming up as the economy expands and India moves from the 10th largest economy to 3rd largest economy in the world. SIM is aimed at future ready and Industry ready skills for our youths.

Under SIM, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship delivers Skill, Re-Skill and Up-Skill training to all the sections of the society, through an extensive network of skill development Centres/Institutes across the country, under various schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs).

Under PMKVY, detailed provisions have been made for proper implementation of skill training for the youths. New courses has been designed and development. 727 courses have been upgraded as per the National Credit Framework (NCrF). These courses include mandatory module of Employability Skill and On-the-Job training
