- a) the list of Indian sites included in the tentative list of UNESCO Heritage list;
- b) year of inclusion, process adopted for selection and reasons for inclusion in tentative list;
- c) whether Ministry supportsState Governments in preparing tentative sites for selection as World Heritage site, details thereof;
- d) whether it is a fact that only one site in tentative list can be recommended every year for final selection by UNESCO as a World Heritage site;
- e) if so, whether it is unfavorable for India with rich ancient cultural heritage; and
- f) efforts made, if any, to relax one nomination per year restriction?

ANSWER

a) &(b): List of India's sites on the tentative list is at Annexure-I. Tentative List is an inventory of those sites situated on its territory which each State Party considers suitable for nomination to the World Heritage List having potential Outstanding Universal Value.

- c) Yes, Sir. Ministry supports State Governments in preparing tentative sites for selection as the World Heritage site and provides all technical assistance, as and when required.
- d) to f) Yes, Sir. It is a fact that only one site from the tentative list can be recommended every year for final selection by UNESCO as a World heritage site.
