- (a) There are 3696 ancient monuments and archaeological sites and remains declared as of national importance in the country, including 13 in the State of Jharkhand.
- (b) The State-wise number of posts with regard to maintenance of monuments lying vacant is given at **Annexure.**
- (c) Filling up of vacancies is a continuous process. Under Mission Recruitment drive of Govt. of India, vacancies have been reported to Recruiting Agencies.
