- (a) whether it is a fact that Manjarabad Fort in Hassan district of Karnataka is the only complete star-shaped fort in India;
- (b) whether it is a fact that the fort is not featured in the ASI list of protected monuments, if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the fort has shown signs of degradation, unchecked growth of plants, cracks, deflection etc., if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether Government has undertaken site-specific restoration for the fort, if so, the details thereof;
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (f) total budget allocated for the fort's maintenance during the last five years?
