MAINTENANCE OF RAMAPPA TEMPLE

2419. DR. K. LAXMAN:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) the quantum of funds allocated and spent for the maintenance of Ramappa temple which is the first and only monument in two Telugu States to be included in the list of UNESCO World Heritage sites buildings during the last five years; and
- (b) the number of tourists who visited these historical buildings and monuments along with the revenue collected from them during the last five years?
