- (a) to (c) Management of forest and wildlife is primarily the responsibility of the respective State/UT Government. The Ministry provides financial assistance to State/UT under Centrally Sponsored Scheme –‘Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats’ on cost sharing basis, for conservation and management of wildlife and development of habitats.
