Will the Minister of Information and Broadcasting be pleased to state:

- (a) whether all Akashvani FM Stations were decided to be shut down by merging with AM stations;
- (b) if not, details of FM stations decided to be shut down;
- (c) reasons for shutting down Ananthapuri FM and Real FM in Kerala by merging with Akashvani AM stations;
- (d) details of casual staffs and artistes who will be rendered jobless by merger;
- (e) whether Government will review its decision considering the fervent appeals to retain these FMs in Kerala;
- (f) whether Government took note of complaints regarding the attempts to replace native language slots in regional FM channels with content in Hindi; and
- (g) if so, the response thereto?
