IMPLEMENTATION OF PM-SYM YOJANA

2484. DR. DHARMASTHALA VEERENDRA HEGGADE:

Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has been implementing Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maan-dhan (PM-SYM) Yojana for unorganised sector workers, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the features, eligibility criteria, enrollment process and the enrollment agencies;
- (c) the details of the number of beneficiaries enrolled under the PM-SYM Yojana so far, State-wise;
- (d) the amount allocated for this Scheme during the last three years;
- (e) the initiatives taken/ being taken to increase the enrolment under PM-SYM Scheme; and
- (f) whether there is any proposal to alter the structure of the scheme and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (f): In order to extend the benefit of old age protection in the form of monthly assured pension of Rs. 3000/- after attaining the age of 60 years, Government had launched Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maandhan Yojana (PM-SYM) for the workers of unorganized sector under section 3(1) of Unorganized Workers Social Security Act, 2008.

It is a voluntary and co-contributory pension scheme meant for the workers of unorganised sector having age between 18-40 years. The premium ranges from Rs. 55/- to 200/- per month depending on the entry age of the beneficiary. Under the scheme, 50% monthly contribution is payable by the beneficiary and equal matching contribution is paid by the Central Government. Enrolment in the scheme is done through the Common Service Centers, which has a network of over 4 lakh centres across the country. In addition, eligible persons can also self-enrol by visiting the portal www.maandhan.in.

The workers in the age group of 18-40 years whose monthly income is Rs. 15000/- or less and are not a member of EPFO/ESIC/NPS (Govt. funded) can join the PM-SYM scheme.

The details of the number of beneficiaries enrolled under the PM-SYM Yojana so far, State-wise is at Annexure-I.

The amount allocated for this Scheme during the last three years is at Annexure-II.

Following are the steps taken for effective implementation of PM-SYM scheme.

- Holding periodic review meeting with States/ UTs at Secretary and Joint Secretary & DGLW level
- ii. Regular Meeting with State CSC Heads were held to promote the enrolment drive for PM-SYM scheme
- iii. Launch of new features: Voluntary EXIT, Involuntary EXIT, Revival Module, Claim Status, and Account Statement
- iv. Extension of revival of dormant accounts from 1 Year to 3 Year
- v. Two-way integration of PM-SYM and e-Shram
- vi. Revamping of Maandhan Portal
- vii. SMS Campaign to create awareness: To create awareness among eShram beneficiaries 7 Crore SMSs sent to eligible subscribers registered under eShram lying in the age group of 18-40 Years
- viii. Launch of extensive social media campaign
 - ix. IEC activities undertaken through states for which 19.58 Crore IEC fund allocated to all the States/ UTs in 2019-20
 - x. Celebration of Pension Week from 7th March to 13th March 2022
 - xi. Letter to Chief Secretaries of States regarding enrolment under PM-SYM scheme
- xii. Launch of Donate-a-Pension Module by Hon'ble LEM to encourage the employer to pay the premium of their staff under PM-SYM pension scheme and increase the enrolment.
- xiii. Meeting with DFS, PFRDA, NIPFP to increase the outreach of pension scheme.

Medium of Intervention:

- Mass campaign through the help of Trade Unions/NGOs/Rural Volunteers/Community Resource persons.
- Interactive Communication through Chart Sheet, Banner & ICE Materials.

xiv. Two days meeting of State/UT Labour & Employment Secretaries held in Agra, Uttar Pradesh for taking collective efforts to cover the uncovered workers so far with Social Security coverage.

At present there is no such proposal to alter the structure of the scheme.
